The intention of conference organizers is to create a forum in which the conclusions of scientific research and practice will be discussed. The authors of papers should be both scientists as well as engineers, mining authorities, local government authorities, etc.

This is another, the XI<sup>th</sup> conference of the series "Days of Mine Surveying and Mining Terrains Protection", organized every two years alternately by Central Mining Institute, AGH University of Science and Technology and Silesian University of Technology.

## DATE AND PLACE OF THE CONFERENCE

The conference will be held on 18 – 20 May 2011 in Hucisko near Włodowice (Cracow-Czestochowa Jura).

## CONFERENCE SCHEDULE

The conference programme offers five thematic sessions:

- technological advance in mine surveying,
- monitoring of mining impact on rock mass, surface and objects,
- prediction of surface deformation and its effects,
- issue of post-mining land development,

- legal, social and economic aspects of mining terrains protection.

After each session, the discussion is planned which the aim should be to show the main directions of further works and researches on these topics.

## CONFERENCE PAPERS

Papers can be reported by all participants of the conference. Some papers will be prepared on request of the organizers. Papers presented at the conference will be published in the GIG Quarterly Mining & Environment and they will be qualified for printing on the basis of the note of the Program Committee of the Conference.

The paper should be prepared according to the attached guidance, which are also available on the website of GIG.

During the conference papers will be lectured or presented in the form of posters.
